Summary of Information

Resolution authorizing and adopting the City of Winston-Salem's 2026 State Legislative Agenda.

Winston-Salem through its State Representation and in conjunction with our lobbyist, submitted bill requests per the 2025 Legislative agenda. In the 2025 "Long" session of the North Carolina General Assembly, the Legislature considered some of the bills; however, the City's requested bill language did not receive final passage. As a result, certain local policy reforms remain unaddressed. The 2026 Legislative agenda includes several of these unaddressed priorities.

In addition, this year, the NC General Assembly introduced many bills that potentially affect the city. In order to respond more swiftly and timely, this agenda introduces a general list of priorities for the City to allow our advocacy partners to actively engage with state legislators as they monitor bill status.

This item approves the City of Winston-Salem Legislative Priorities for the 2026 Legislative Session, which are attached.
