WHEREAS: The City has one undergraduate chapter: the Pi Omicron Chapter at Wake Forest

University; and

WHEREAS: The major programs of the sorority are centered on the organization's Five Point

2. Educational Development

3. International Awareness and Involvement

4. Physical and Mental Health

5. Political Awareness and Involvement; and
