## **Summary of Information:**

The Department of Transportation received a request to install on-street handicap parking spaces at two locations: 630 North Liberty Street and 615 Trade Street.

Mr. John Jackson, Director for Events at the Art for Art's Sake (AFAS) Center requested for two on-street handicap spaces at 630 North Liberty Street. An existing ramp is available at this location, therefore, the installation of a new curb ramp will not be required. Attached is a map of the proposed location of the handicap spaces (Attachment A). AFAS uses on-street parking along Liberty Street, but there is nowhere for handicap patrons to get to the front handicap entrance ramp.

Mr. Richard Miller, property owner of 615 Trade Street requested for two on-street handicap parking spaces at 615 Trade Street. When feasible, proposed handicap parking spaces are located adjacent to existing ramps. Existing ramps are not available at this location, therefore, the installation of a new curb ramp will be required. Attached is a map of the proposed location of the handicap spaces and a new handicap curb ramp (Attachment B).
