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**RESOLUTION AWARDING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR
CEDAR TRAIL AND PETREE ROAD SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, after proper advertisement and re-advertisement, bids were received and publicly opened by City/County Purchasing City/County Purchasing at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 30, 2024, for sidewalk improvements along Cedar Trail and Petree Road, and the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, the low bidder, BW Infrastructure, LLC, agreed to the M/WBE subcontracting goals established for this project of 12.0% with minority-owned businesses and 8.0% with women-owned businesses; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that a contract be awarded to BW Infrastructure, LLC, the low bidder meeting specifications, for construction of the Cedar Trail and Petree Road sidewalk improvements for the estimated amount of \$2,097,286.80.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, upon approval by the Finance Committee, that the contract for the Cedar Trail and Petree Road sidewalk improvements is hereby awarded to BW Infrastructure, LLC in the estimated amount of \$2,097,286.80. The City Manager and City Clerk are authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the City, with contract and bond forms to be approved by the City Attorney and bid deposit retained until the successful bidder has provided satisfactory contract, performance and payment bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of this contract constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidder. The City is not legally bound until the contract is duly executed by the City. The bid deposit may be retained if the bidder fails to execute the contract or give satisfactory surety as required by N.C.G.S. 143-129.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that BW Infrastructure, LLC will be required to subcontract, as a minimum, 12.0% of this contract with certified minority-owned businesses and 8.0% with certified women-owned businesses as indicated on the Affidavit "C" submitted by the company.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds have been previously appropriated in the approved FY2023-24 budget to partially fund this contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a project budget amendment follows the Resolution allocating an additional \$955,000 of funding for this project.
