Council Member Larson asked for an update on getting residents from Granville Retirement Home to Hanes Mall. He wants an update on a bus route/stop. He also requested that when there are changes in routes; and wants a review of the Route 100 and how it is used and perceived.

Council Member MacIntosh asked about using different size buses. It was brought up by former Assistant City Manager, Greg Turner in the past that the size of the bus does not really change the costs much.

Council Member Montgomery asked that it be made known that there are single use passes. He asked for a date that City Council made changes to Route 100 and for there to be a different way to measure ridership because WSSU students may only use the buses for a specific period of time, compared to everyday work-goers.

Council Member Larson asked what has been accomplished with Bond and Annual Resurfacing money in the South Ward? He wants a report on how money has been spent in his ward specifically.

Council Member Besse wanted to know when certain streets had become Priority 1 verses Priority 2 or 3, and that Priority 1 would be the only items contracted out and completed this year. He asked the City Manager for a timeline of specific streets in the SW Ward, like Cliffdale or Sheldonham, and would they be completed in June 2019?

Council Member Larson asked for clarity and priority on the completion dates for priority 2 and 3 from previous years.

Council Member Montgomery asked to keep brick paving in areas where they already exist.

Council Member Larson wants a list of streets in the South Ward so he can start prioritize them based on citizens thoughts and not solely based on the evaluation of the department of transportation.

Council Member Besse asked if there is a way to speed up the process of internal sidewalk designs from engineers, as well as a month by month update on crosswalk at Miller Street and Silas Creek Parkway across from Forsyth Tech. This Report was Presented.
