Resolution to Adopt the Northern Piedmont Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan

## **Summary of Information:**

Winston-Salem is vulnerable to various natural and manmade hazards that can impact the community. One way that a community can plan and prepare for these hazards is to complete a hazard mitigation plan. Hazard mitigation planning reduces loss of life and property by minimizing the impact of disasters. It begins with local governments identifying natural disaster risks and common vulnerabilities in their area. After identifying these risks, they develop long-term strategies for protecting people and property from similar events. Plan adoption is a key requirement; each jurisdiction must complete the mitigation planning process, receive plan approval, and meet the mitigation plan requirement for specific State and FEMA assistance programs. The City of Winston-Salem, in coordination with Caswell, Davie, Forsyth, Rockingham, Stokes, Surry, and Yadkin Counties and the participating municipalities within those Counties, has prepared a regional, multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan with input from the appropriate local and state officials.
