Summary of Information:	
The City of Winston-Salem joined with thousands of local governments across the country to file lawsuits against opioid manufacturers, pharmaceutical distribution companies, and chain drug stores to hold those companies accountable for their misconduct. A settlement has been reached in litigation against eight opioids manufacturers, Alvogen, Amneal, Apotex, Hikma, Indivior, Mylan, Sun, and Zydus; as well as Purdue and the Sackler family. By joining the settlements and approving this settlement, the state and local governments maximize North Carolina's share of opioid settlement funds to ensure the needed resources reach communities, as quickly, effectively, and directly as possible. The attached resolution, which is recommended for your approval, authorizes the appropriate city officials to sign onto the settlements to demonstrate solidarity in response to the opioid overdose crisis and maximize the share of opioid settlement funds received by state and local governments to help abate the harm.
