## **Summary of Information:**

Piedmont Regional Greenway is a portion of an approximately 8.5 mile multi-use path system that will connect the City of Winston-Salem, Forsyth County, and the town of Kernersville to Guilford County. This project will extend approximately 1.25 miles from the existing Salem Creek Greenway and Salem Lake Trail at Linville Road to Hastings Hill Road towards the Town of Kernersville. This project provides for the construction of a 10 foot wide paved multi-use path with grass shoulders and slopes, including construction of a pedestrian culvert under Hastings Hill Road and improvements to the existing culvert under US-421 in order to accommodate the multi-use path.

It is necessary that the City of Winston-Salem acquire easements which are needed for the Piedmont Regional Greenway Project as shown in the attached Exhibit A in the amount of \$3,075, based on an appraisal. The costs associated with the purchase or condemnation will be charged to the Piedmont Regional Greenway Project.

The attached resolution authorizes staff to proceed with the acquisition of the easements as stated herein.
