Summary of Information:

Cottage Hill is a new residential development located off Robinhood Road. The Cottage Hill Homeowners Association, Inc. desires to have decorative lights on decorative poles. This streetlighting system, available through Duke Energy to the City, costs more than standard streetlighting. The Cottage Hill Homeowners Association, Inc. has agreed to pay the up-front decorative adder charges for 17 Open Traditional decorative lights as required by the Streetlighting Policy and is eligible for City participation in the cost of the streetlighting. The City's participation is limited to the cost of a standard non-decorative streetlighting system.

There will be a recurring annual electrical and administrative charge to The Cottage Hill Homeowners Association, Inc. The Cottage Hill Homeowners Association, Inc. will be responsible for paying the amount which exceeds the cost to provide standard streetlighting. These charges will be paid annually for the entire length of the ten-year contract period with the first billing cycle to begin one year after the contract agreement.
