RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A REVISED CODE OF CONDUCT AND BAN POLICY FOR THE CLARK CAMPBELL TRANSPORTATION CENTER, HAMPTON HAITH ADMINISTRATIVE AND MAINTENANCE FACILITY, AND PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the Clark Campbell Transportation Center located at 100 West Fifth Street and the Hampton Haith Facility located at 1060 North Trade Street are public facilities of the City of Winston-Salem managed by the Transit Service Provider; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Winston-Salem Transit Authority (WSTA) is to provide the general public and transit passengers with safe and reliable transportation services at the Clark Campbell Transportation Center, the Hampton Haith Administrative and Maintenance facilities as well as while being transported on public transportation vehicles; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of City of Winston-Salem, the WSTA, and the contracted security firm to provide the public with facilities that are clean, safe, and free of disorderly conduct and illegal activities; and

WHEREAS, the Code of Conduct and Ban Policy establishes a defined list of unauthorized behaviors and violations that will be enforced on any property owned by the City of Winston-Salem and managed by the Transit Authority or any governmental agency, firm or corporation contracting with the City of Winston-Salem; and

WHEREAS, the City of Winston-Salem Department of Transportation and WSTA request the adoption of the revised WSTA Code of Conduct and Ban Policy.
