Late Fees for Failure to Obtain Permit: Work performed without a permit in violation of City Code shall be subject to a late fee equal in amount to the fees specified for the work and in addition thereto. The late fee shall not be construed as a penalty but as a charge for additional administrative expense, at the discretion of the Fire Chief.
