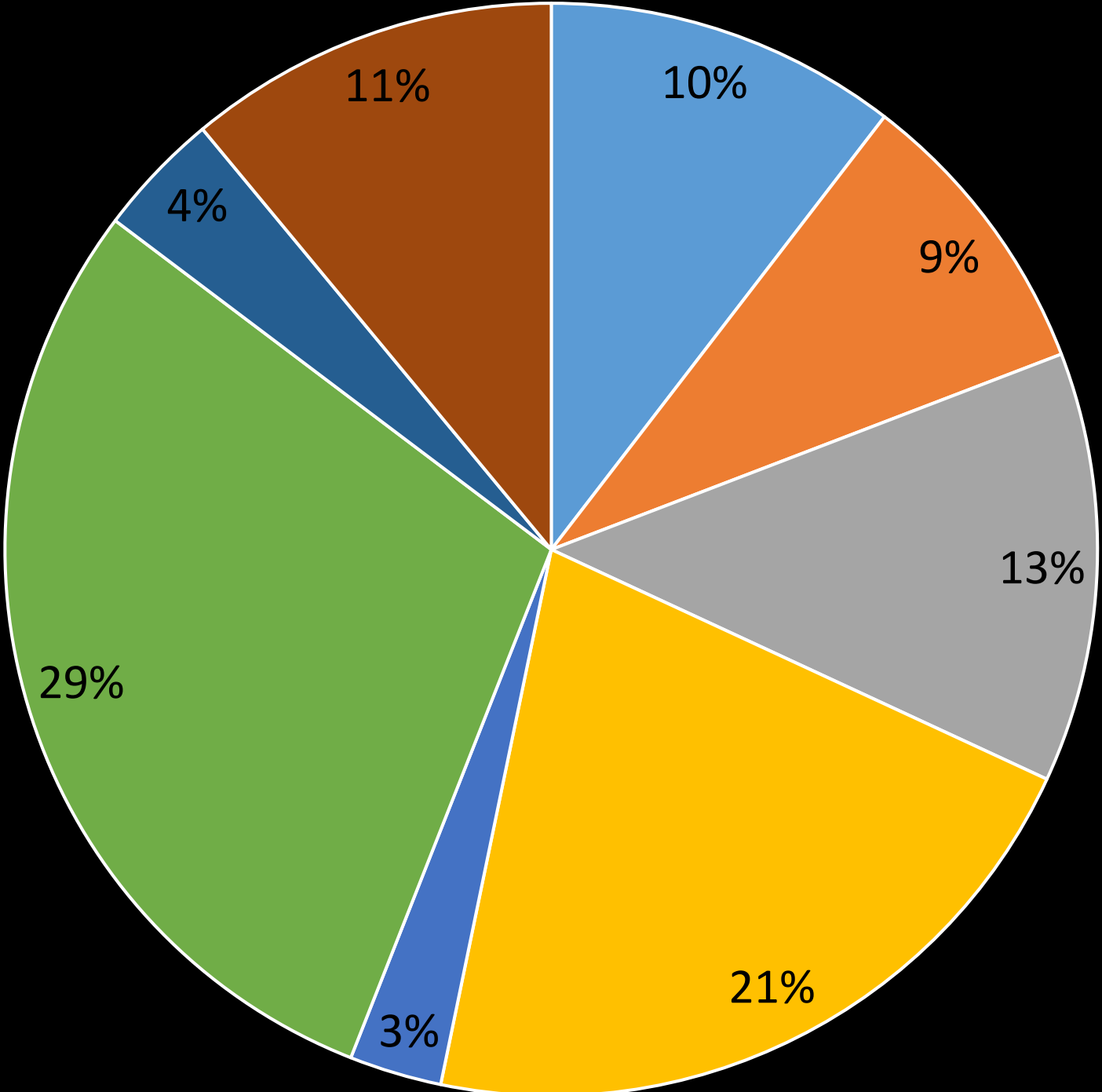

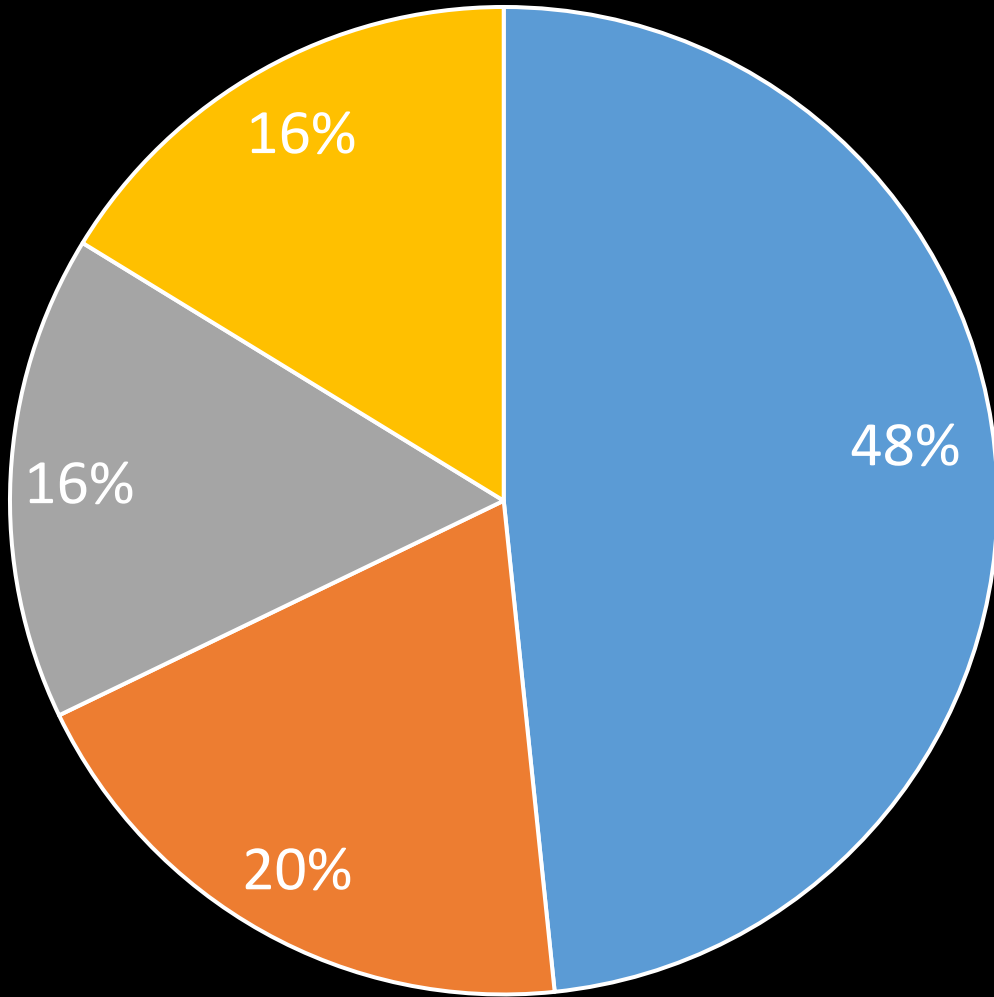

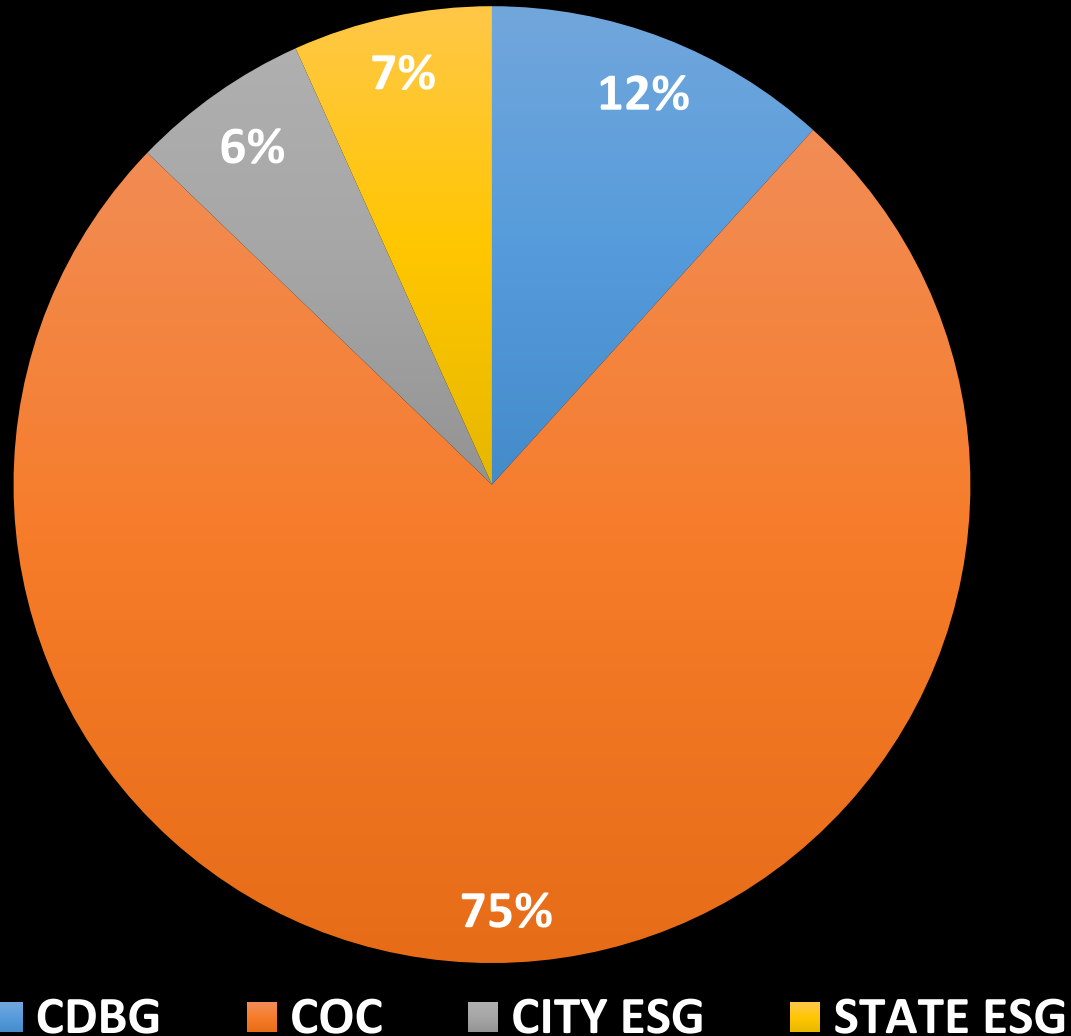

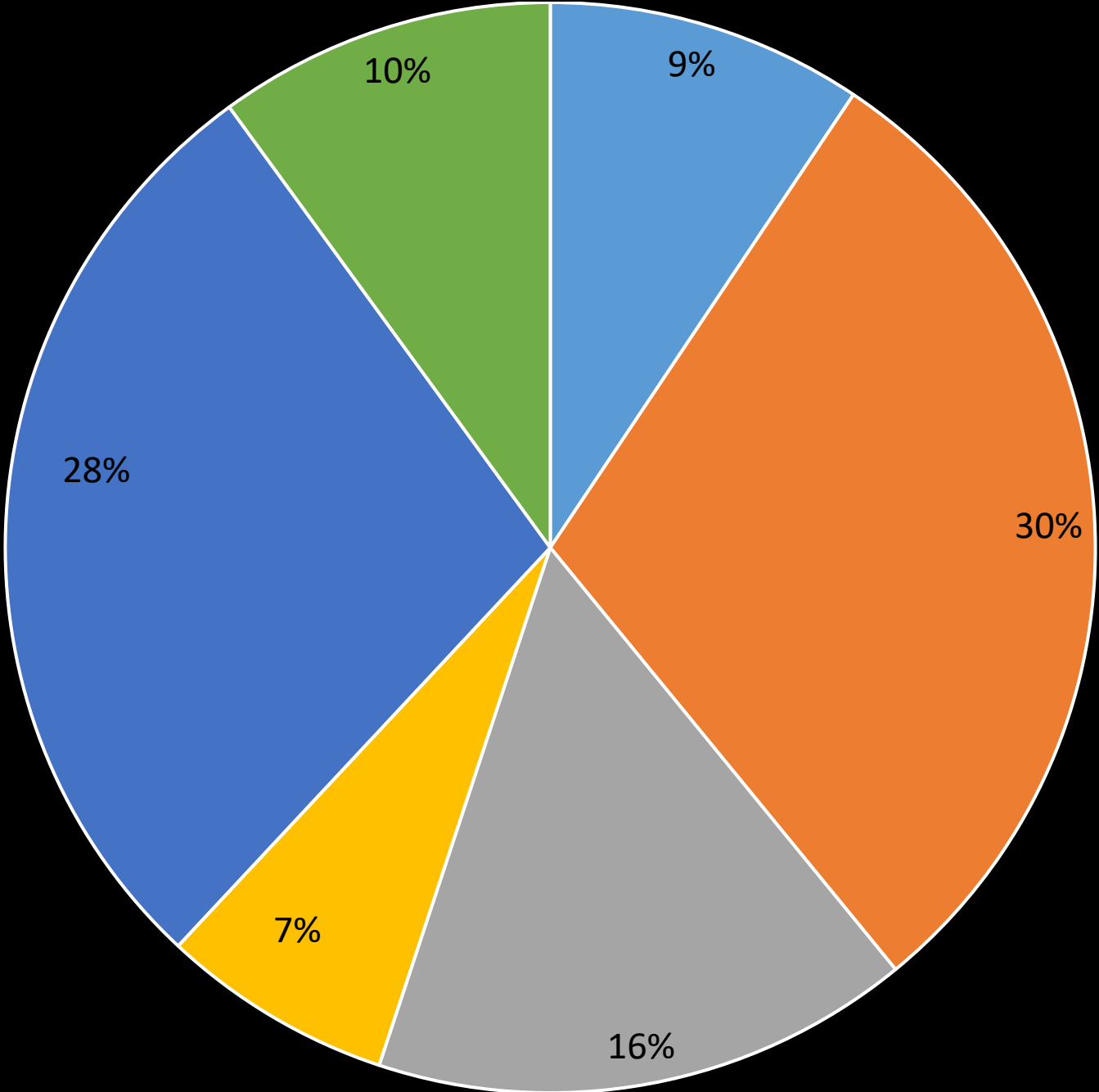

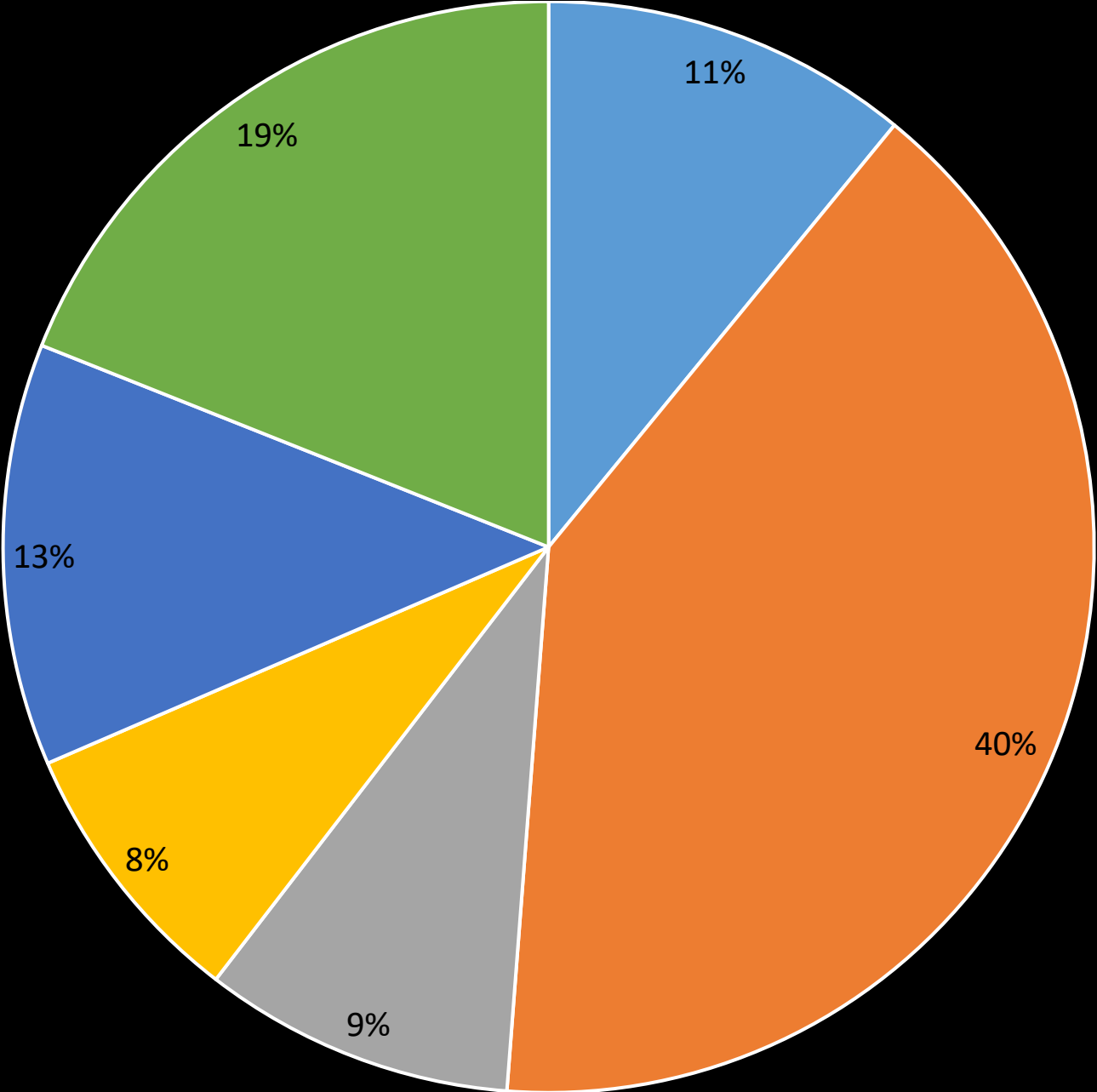

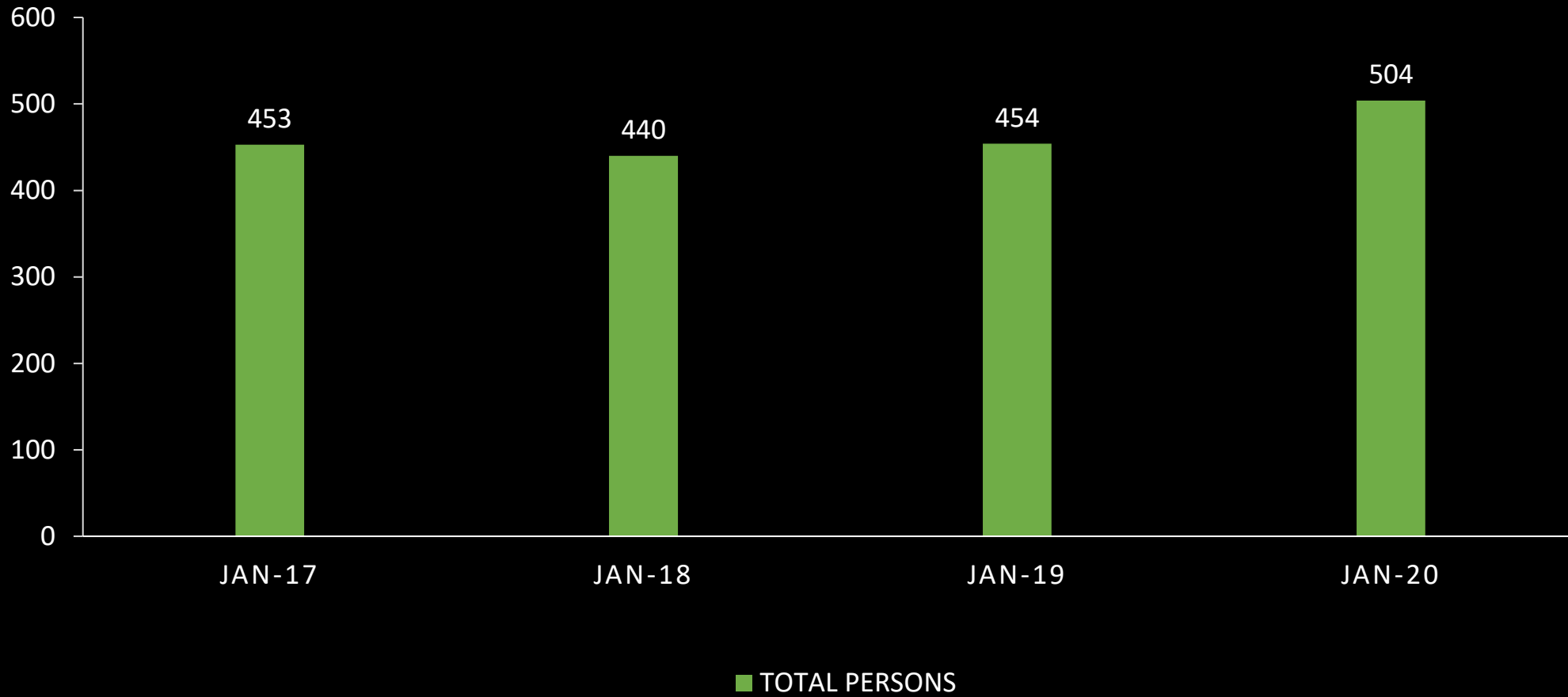

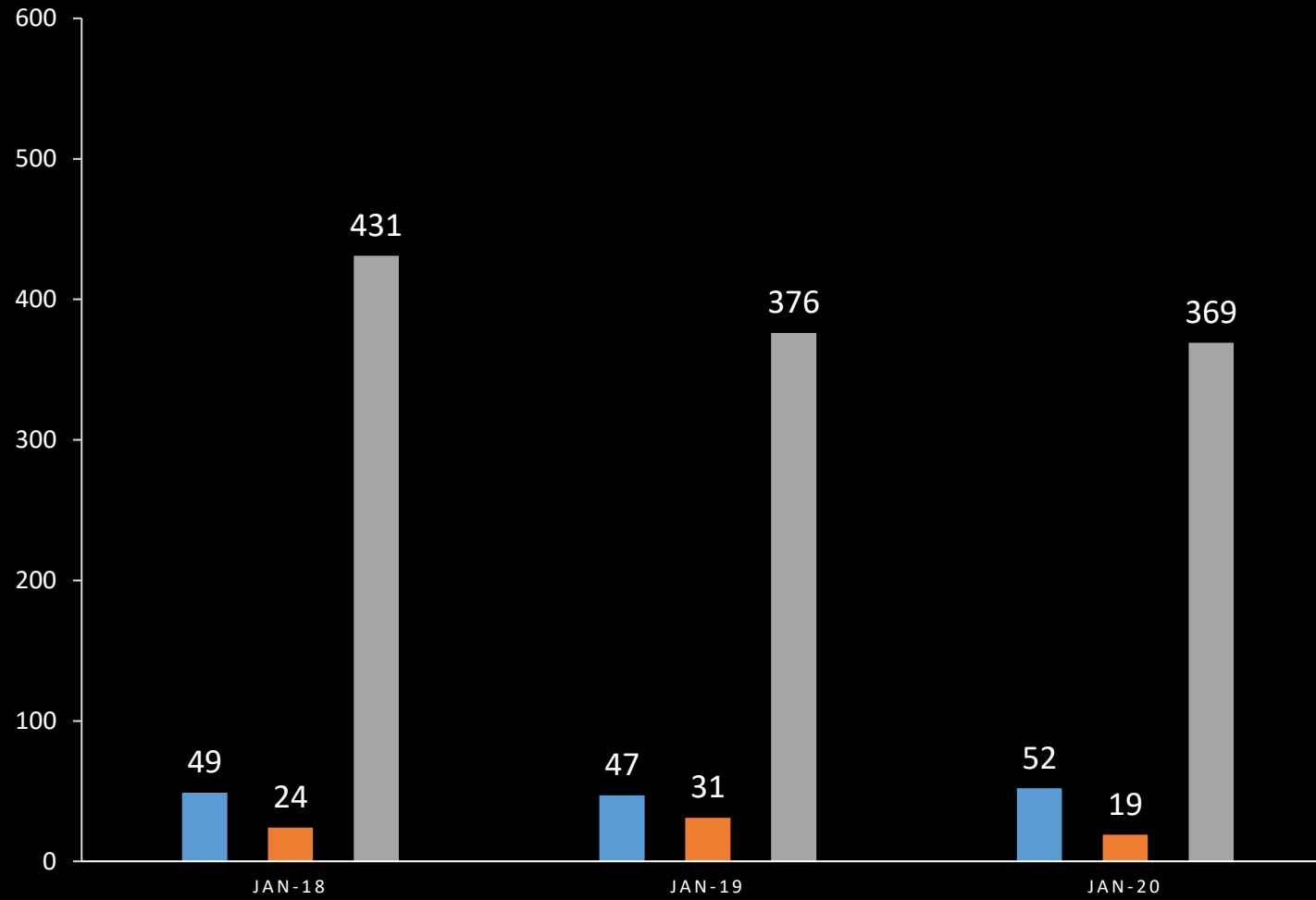

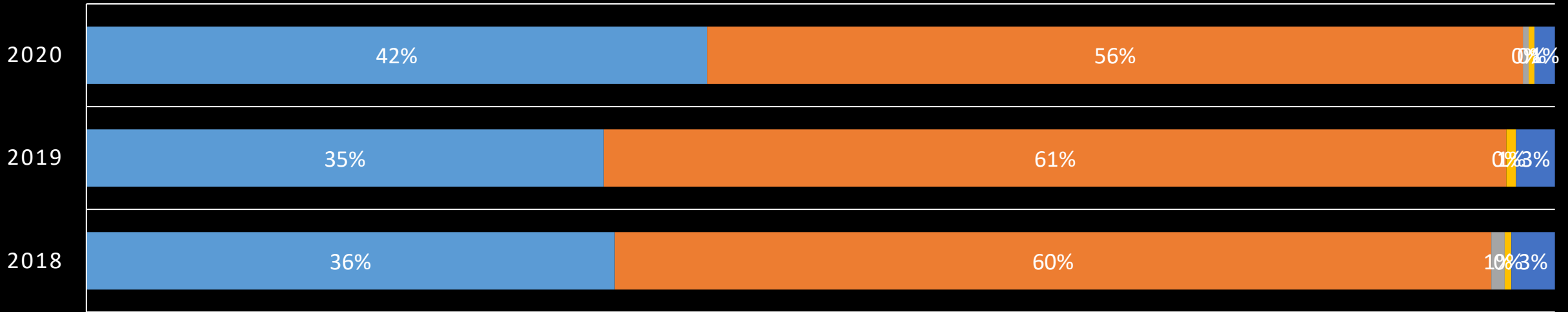

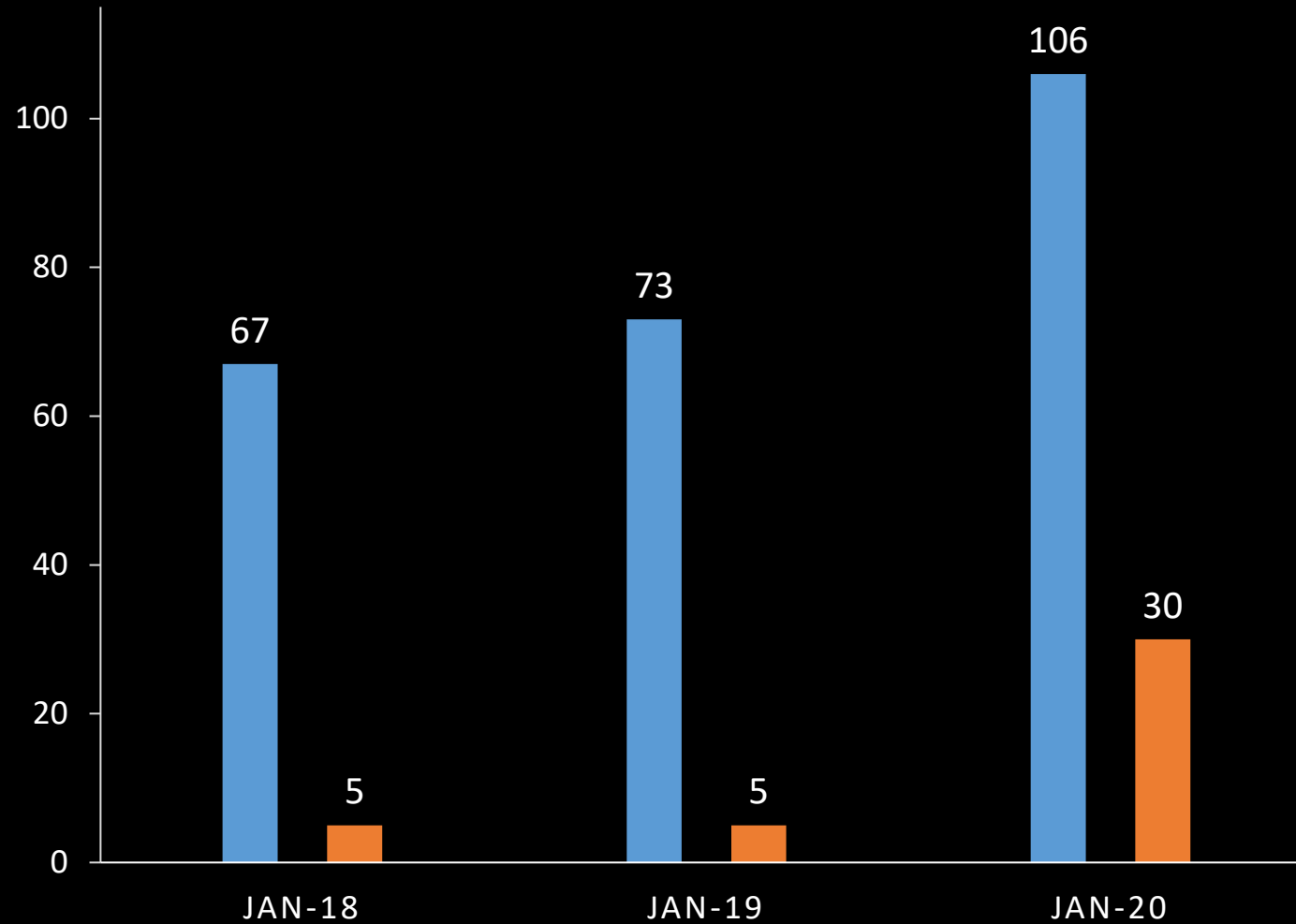

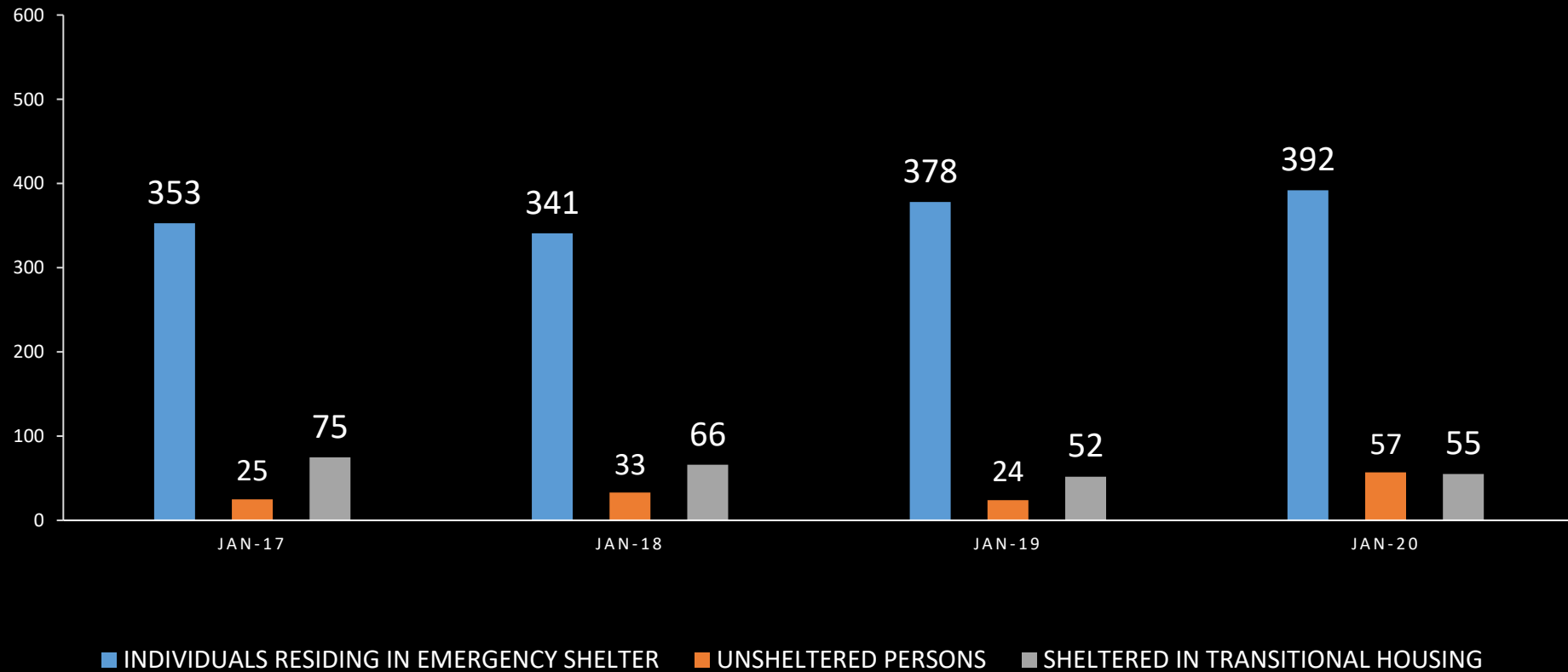

In Shelter Unsheltered

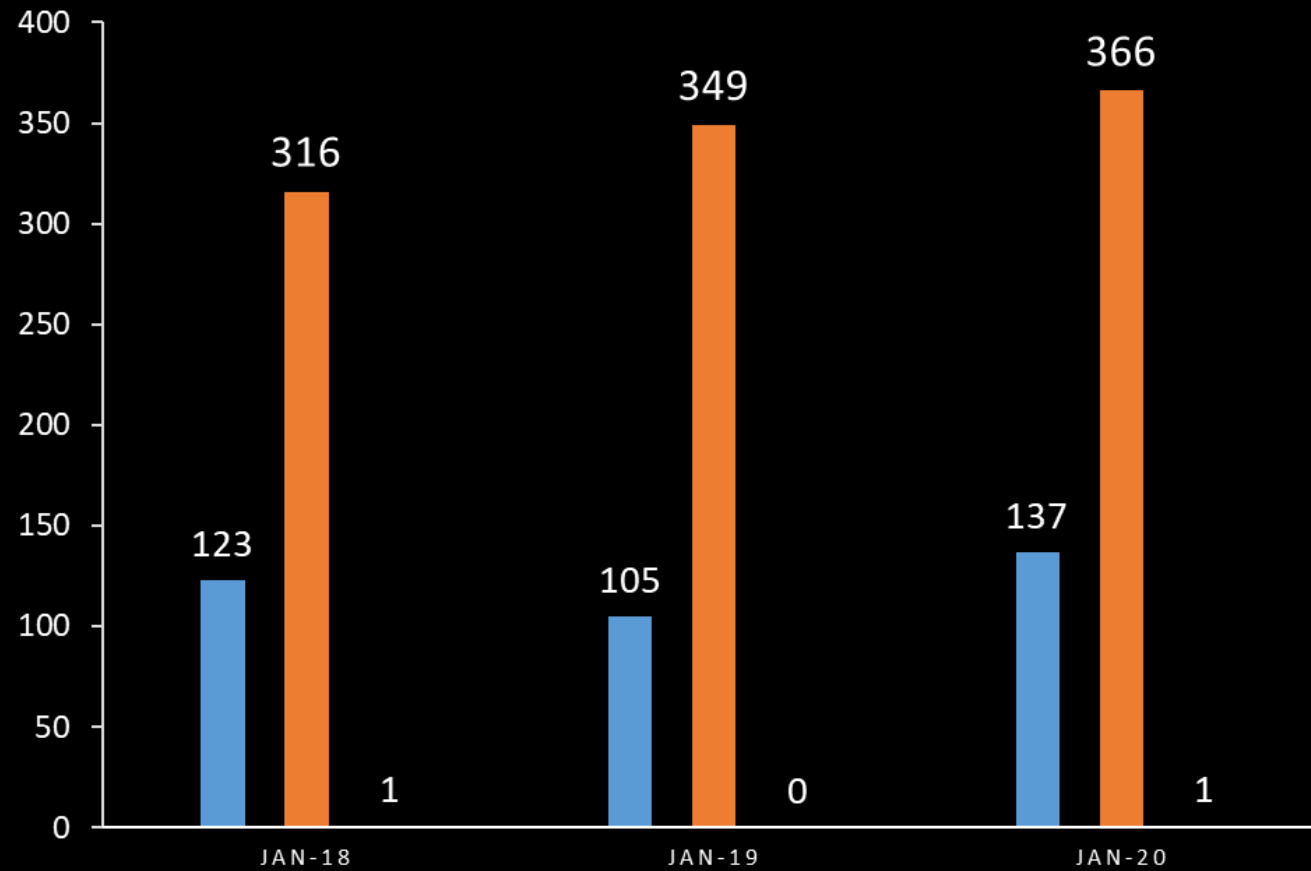


POINT IN TIME COUNT TOTALS BY HOMELESSNESS SETTING
