## **Summary of Information:**

The Winston-Salem Area Transportation Planning Organization (WSATPO), housed within the City of Winston-Salem Department of Transportation (WSDOT), is the federally designated and funded organization for transportation planning in the Winston-Salem Urban Area. The WSATPO serves as a forum for local decision-making on transportation funding and planning across twelve municipalities, portions of four counties, three transit agencies, Smith Reynolds Airport, North Carolina Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, and the Federal Transit Administration.

WSATPO staff will provide an overview of the Transportation Planning Organization, its purpose, structure, and key functions within the City of Winston-Salem organization and region. The presentation will also provide an update on current TPO planning initiatives, funding information, and ongoing infrastructure projects.
