Historic Resources staff has reviewed the 15 properties that are scheduled to go before the Community Development/Housing/General Government Committee on September 12, 2017 for demolition consideration. Below is a list of contributing structures in National Register of Historic Places districts.

**Properties located in National Register Historic Districts:**

914 N. Jackson Avenue - **Reynoldstown Historic District**

853 Graham Avenue - **Reynoldstown Historic District**

1252 Clemmonsville Road- **Waughtown/Belview Historic District**

Historic Resources staff has concerns about the loss of structures in the City's National Register Historic Districts; therefore, I have sent notice to Preservation Forsyth, the local Historic Preservation non-profit organization to advise them of this potential loss. Their mission is to promote, protect, and advocate for Historic Resources in Forsyth County. None of the buildings are designated a Local Historic Landmark or located within designated local historic districts. If demolition for these structures are approved, Historic Resources staff would like to request that the Community Development Department have the structures professionally photo-documented, submitting the photos to the Forsyth County Historic Resources Commission and any architectural elements be salvaged from the house prior to demolition.
