Summary of Information:

The American Rescue Plan Act appropriated \$5 billion to be administered through the HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) program (HOME-ARP funds). As HOME funds, they are awarded to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth Housing Consortium and may be used countywide. The Consortium's HOME-ARP allocation is \$4,887,567 and must be used to provide housing, services, and shelter to individuals experiencing homelessness and other vulnerable populations.

To access funds, the City of Winston-Salem, as lead entity of the Consortium, must submit a HOME-ARP Allocation Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) describing how it plans to distribute HOME-ARP funds to meet the needs of homeless and other vulnerable populations. The Plan proposes focusing HOME-ARP funds on rental housing, including permanent supportive housing, and supportive services.

The accompanying resolution approves the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan for submission to HUD.
