Week, as sponsored by the National Association of Students Against

Violence Everywhere (SAVE) and Sandy Hook Promise; and

WHEREAS: The purpose of this week is to look at the different instances of youth

violence that have occurred, nationwide, over the past few years; and

WHEREAS: The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) defines youth violence as the

intentional use of physical force or power to threaten or harm others by young people, ages 10-24, including bullying, fighting, threats, weapons,

and gang-related violence; and

WHEREAS: Homicide is the third leading cause of death for youth, ages 10-24, and the

leading cause of death for non-Hispanic African-American youth; and

WHEREAS: The Youth Advisory Council, College Advisory Board, and Human

Relations Commission are advisory boards that advise the City of Winston-

Salem on challenges and solutions amongst our local youth; and

WHEREAS: After more than two years of increased gun sales, we renew our

commitment to collaborate with public safety and school officials, as well as local organizations, to address the increase in city gun violence that results in increased suicides and instances of domestic violence; and

WHEREAS: We renew our commitment to welcome the voices of our youth to reduce

gun violence and to do all we can to reduce gun violence to help keep our

children safe.
