Summary of Information:

At the February 8, 2022 Public Works Committee meeting, staff presented revisions to Chapters 74 and 78 of the City Code related to the operation of golf carts on public streets. Specifically, the revisions discussed at the February meeting focused on allowing hospitals to use golf carts on public streets to transport people and goods from their main campus to off-site properties that support the hospital. City Council approved said revisions during their February 21, 2022 meeting.

During the discussion at Public Works Committee, staff was asked to research and draft a subsequent amendment that would include colleges/universities, churches, and historic districts. The attached ordinance amendment provides the requested revisions.
