

WHEREAS, notice, if required under GS 160A-299, was given to the State Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the satisfaction of the City Council of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, that the closing of an Unnamed Alleyway off of Indiana Avenue is not contrary to the public interest and that no other individual owning property adjoining, abutting or in the vicinity of said right-of-way will thereby be deprived of reasonable means of ingress and egress to his property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, which Unnamed Alleyway off of Indiana Avenue, as herein referred to, and being more particularly described as follows:

Approximately a 115 foot portion of an Alley running West from a separate Alley running south from the 3000 block of Indiana Avenue. The Alley is 15 feet in width and approximately 250 feet from the Southern Right-of-Way of Indiana Avenue.

is hereby ordered closed, subject to the City of Winston-Salem's reservation of all of its rights, titles, and interests in any utility, drainage, pedestrian/sidewalk, landscaping, and conservation improvements, and the City of Winston-Salem's reservation of an easement in the entire area hereinabove described for the construction, inspection, operation, maintenance, repair, rehabilitation, reconstruction, replacement, and expansion of pedestrian sidewalk, landscaping, and all public utilities located therein, or to be located therein, including water, sewer and storm drainage lines and facilities.
