- Clear width requirements of not less than 20 feet for two-way traffic;
- Clear height requirements of not less than 13 feet, 6 inches;
- Design, construction and maintenance of approved turnaround designs for fire apparatus access roads when the dead-end length of the required access road is more than 150 feet.
- Gates may not obstruct fire apparatus access roads unless approved by the Winston-Salem Fire Department; approval requires compliance with all applicable fire code requirements.

Developments that disturb less than 1 acre during construction are exempt from The City of Winston-Salem's Post Construction Stormwater Management Ordinance water quality provisions and developments that create less than 20,000 sq.ft. of new impervious area are exempt from the water quantity provisions of the ordinance. This proposed development meets Site Plan Amendment - both of these exemptions and thus is not required to be issued with a Post Construction Stormwater Management permit. Therefore, no comments.
