**ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 78-358(b) OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO  
TROLLEY PUB ROUTES AND STOPS ON CITY STREETS**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem as follows:

**SECTION I.** Section.78-358(b) of the City Code relating to Area of Operation and Trolley Pub Stops is amended as shown below:

(b) The public works committee of the city council shall establish trolley pub stops on such streets, in such places, and in such number as the committee determines to be of the greatest benefit and convenience to the general public. Each such stop shall be designated by appropriate signs. Trolley pubs shall stop at such trolley pub stops only for the purpose of, and for the time required to, load or unload passengers. The trolley pub stops established pursuant to this subsection shall be established at the following locations:

- (1) It shall be unlawful for a trolley pub to stop, stand or park anywhere other than at a designated trolley pub stop, in a legal parking space, provided that any fee for occupying the space is paid, at a traffic light/signal or at the garage or parking lot where the trolley pub is kept when not in use, provided that nothing in this subsection shall be construed to prohibit a trolley pub from stopping at the scene of an accident, if necessary, or from parking pending the removal of an incapacitated vehicle from the street.
- (2) It shall be unlawful for any vehicle, other than a trolley pub, to stop, stand or park at a designated trolley pub stop.
- (3) On-street trolley pub stops shall be established at the following locations:
  - a. Trade Street in the parking lot at 632 N. Trade Street
  - b. Fourth Street in front of Stevens Center just west of Marshall Street
  - c. Fifth Street just west of Cherry Street
  - d. Liberty Street at 517 N Liberty Street

**SECTION II.** This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption by the City Council and upon the erection of appropriate signs and markings giving notice thereof.
