

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION AND TAX LEVY
ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM, NORTH CAROLINA
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that the Annual Appropriation and Tax Levy Ordinance for the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 be amended to appropriate federal CARES Act funds received by Forsyth County and transfer funds from the Police Department to provide for community anti-poverty initiatives, to increase the City’s minimum hourly rate to \$14.31 (effective January 1, 2021), and to provide for a 1% public safety supplemental pay adjustment (effective January 1, 2021).

SECTION 1. That the Annual Appropriation and Tax Levy Ordinance of the City of Winston-Salem, adopted on June 15, 2020, shall be further amended by changing the expenditure appropriations in the following fund.
