

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE SILAS CREEK
PARKWAY SIDEWALK PROJECT**

WHEREAS, in 2019, the City of Winston-Salem entered into a municipal agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) for sidewalk construction and intersection improvements on Silas Creek Parkway from Bolton Street to Lockland Avenue (EB-5722); and

WHEREAS, this project was partially funded by federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) and Transportation Alternatives Program Any Area (TAANY), with the City providing a 20% local match; and

WHEREAS, the total project cost is \$8,553,722, with a non-federal match (20%) of \$1,710,744; and

WHEREAS, staff was made aware of additional federal funding available through the Winston-Salem Area Transportation Planning Organization (WSATPO) and in May 2025 the City of Winston-Salem applied for additional federal funding; and

WHEREAS, the City received \$474,978 in Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funds and \$1,611,744 in funding through the NCDOT Toll Credit Pilot Program. The Toll Credit Program was designed to help local governments cover the non-federal matching share (20%) for federal-aid transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, the \$1,611,744 from the Toll Credit Program will cover most of the non-federal match for the Silas Creek Parkway Sidewalk Project (EB-5722). The City will be responsible for \$99,000 of the remaining non-federal match; and

WHEREAS, the City's portion of the non-federal match has previously been appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, that the City Manager and City Clerk are authorized to enter into a Supplemental Agreement with NCDOT for additional funding for sidewalk construction and intersection improvements on Silas Creek Parkway.
