WHEREAS: the City has one undergraduate chapter: the Pi Omicron Chapter at Wake Forest

University; and

WHEREAS: the major programs of the sorority are centered on the organization's Five Point

Programmatic Thrust:

2. Educational Development

3. International Awareness and Involvement

4. Physical and Mental Health

5. Political Awareness and Involvement; and

WHEREAS: members of the Sorority are active in local, state and national politics; and the group has
