A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE WINSTON-SALEM BOARD OF ALDERMEN TO GRANT SUBPOENA POWER TO THE WINSTON-SALEM CITIZEN POLICE REVIEW BOARD.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Subpoena Power.

The Board of Aldermen may adopt ordinances granting to the Winston-Salem Citizen Police Review Board the authority to:

- (1) Subpoena witnesses, request and require answers to interrogatories, request and require the production of documents and things, and administer oaths.
- (2) Apply to the General Court of Justice, upon failure of any person to respond to or to comply with a lawful interrogatory, request for production of documents and things, or subpoena, for an order requiring such person to respond to or comply with the subpoena, request for interrogatories or production of documents or things.

Sec. 2. Information and Records.

No information or record, which would otherwise be confidential, gathered or reviewed by the Winston-Salem Citizen Police Review Board shall be subject to disclosure, examination, or copying pursuant to Chapter 132 of the General Statutes, and said information or record shall remain confidential as provided by G.S. 160A-168 of the General Statutes.
