The City Council of the City of Winston-Salem issues a Special Use Limited District Permit for the zoning petition of City of Winston-Salem, (Zoning Docket W-3605). The site shall be developed in accordance with the conditions approved by the Board and the following uses: (Residential Building Single-Family; Residential Building, Twin Home; Residential Building, Townhome; and Residential Building, Multi-Family), approved by the Winston-Salem City Council the 8th day of January, 2024" and signed, provided the property is developed in accordance with requirements of the RM18-L zoning district of the Zoning Ordinance of the Unified Development Ordinances, the Erosion Control Ordinance, and other applicable laws, and the following additional conditions be met:

• PRIOR TO ISSUANCE OF GRADING PERMITS:

- a. The developer shall obtain a driveway permit from the City of Winston-Salem and/or NCDOT; additional improvements may be required prior to the issuance of driveway permits. Required improvements include:
 - Installation of sidewalks along Old Walkertown Road from the northeastern terminus of existing sidewalks to the intersection of Mount Pleasant Drive.
