










Total: 3,489 Part 2 Crimes Cleared in 2025










### Armed Robbery

Approximate time frame from 911 call to apprehension = 47 minutes

## Robbery of a Person (Drone as a First Responder)

Approximate time from 911 call to apprehension = 25 minutes

### Missing Person

Approximate time frame from 911 call to locating child = 2 hours
