**Summary of Information:**

At the August 13<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Community Development/Housing/General Government Committee, City staff recounted the process to receive public input on changing the name of the Dixie Classic Fair and presented a resolution directing staff to engage a consultant to develop a new name. Members of the committee raised concerns about the potential cost to hire a consultant and noted that the decision to change the name resided with the Mayor and City Council.

As a result of their discussion, the committee approved sending forward the following resolutions as part of a two-part process for the Council's consideration at the regular meeting on August 19<sup>th</sup>.
