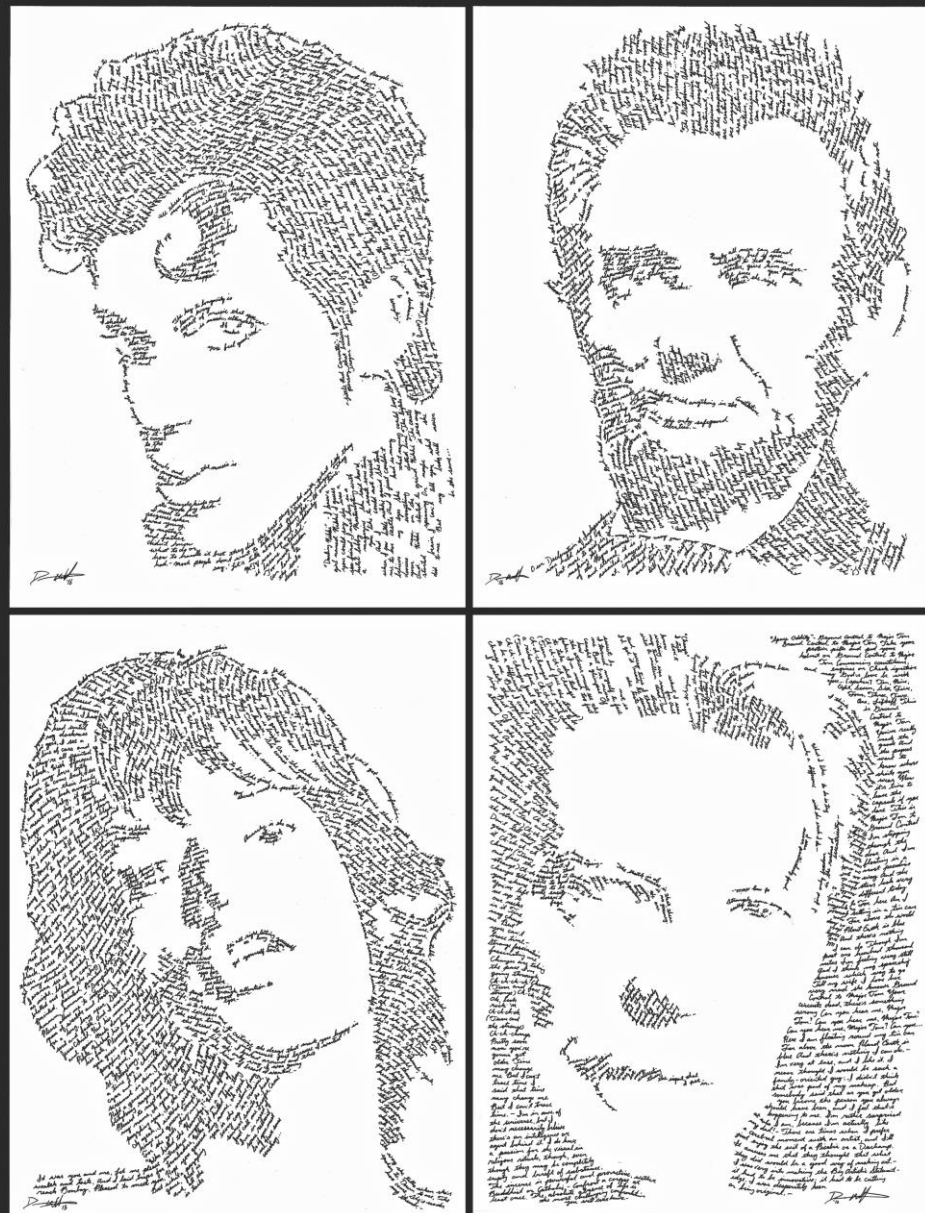

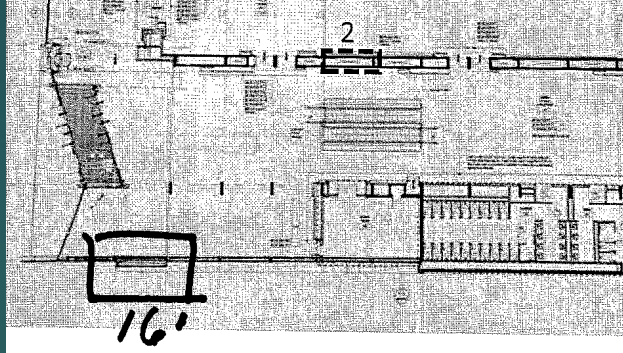

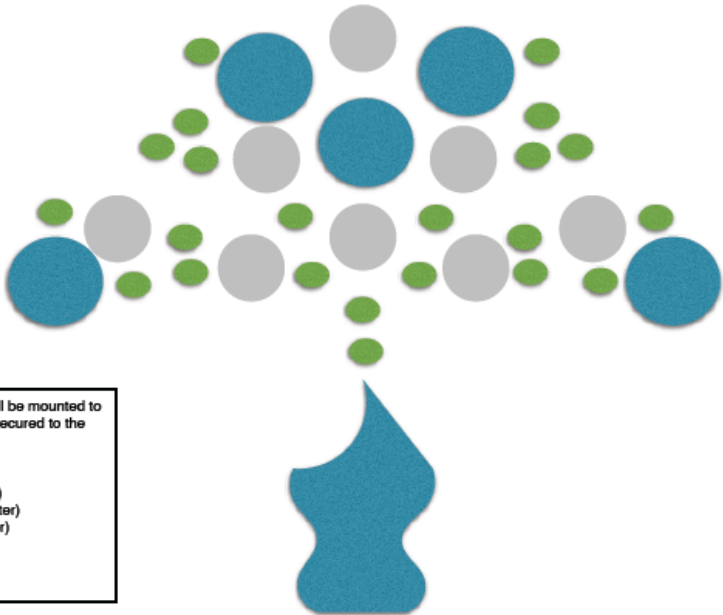

Plates of three different sizes will be mounted to the wall. One sculpture will be secured to the floor.

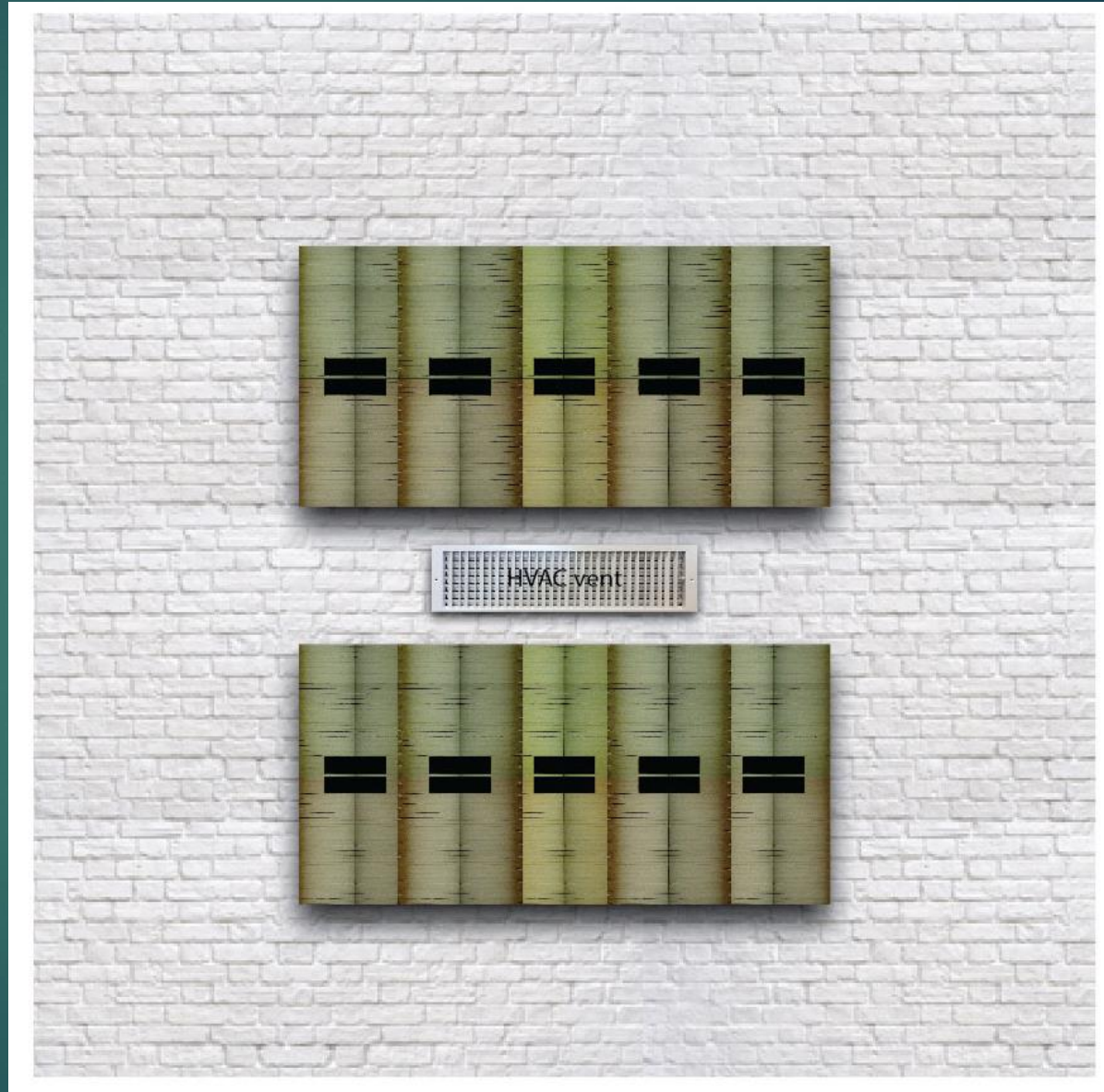
Contains:

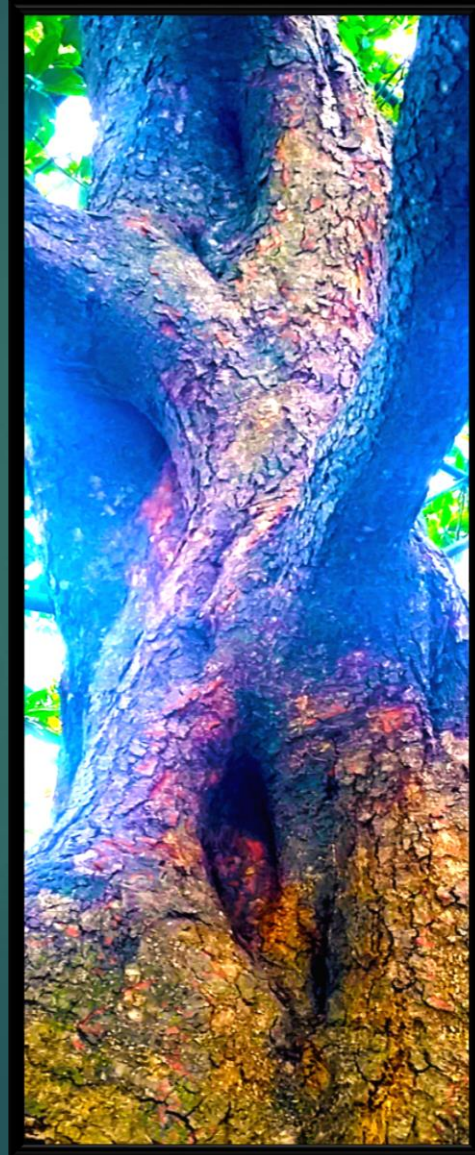

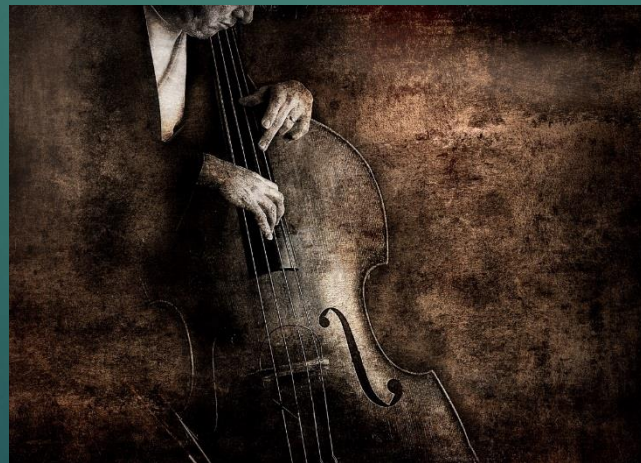
