Summary of Information:

On September 21, 1998, the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem adopted an Ordinance to cause the dwelling located at 3919 Old Vineyard Road to be demolished. This action was taken as a result of the owner's failure to comply with a duly issued Order to repair or demolish the dwelling which was unfit for human habitation as prescribed in the Housing Code of the City of Winston-Salem.

After the Ordinance was adopted, the owner made the necessary repairs to render the dwelling fit for human habitation as prescribed in the Housing code of the City of Winston Salem.

The owner has requested that the City Council of the City of Winston Salem rescind the Ordinance adopted September 21, 1998, allowing the ordinance of record relating to said property to be cancelled.
