Summary of Information:
 By the attached resolution, staff is requesting permission to sell all items listed on Exhibit A, which includes the following surplus motor vehicles and equipment:

This surplus personal property has been determined by Fleet or Risk Management to be obsolete, outmoded, or unsuitable for its intended use, or exceeds Fleet’s criteria for continued use, and the disposal of which would be to the financial benefit of the City. All vehicles, which have been removed from service, are either wrecked or in need of extensive repairs and maintenance that would be cost prohibitive.

If approved, local non-profit organizations will be notified, and notice will be published on the City website. Surplus items will be offered for sale by public electronic auction by Rogers Realty & Auction Co. at RogersAuctionGroup.com. Bids will be received during the week preceding the stated closing time of each auction item between 1:00 and 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 1, 2024. Any items remaining unsold after the auction may be sold by a subsequent electronic or live auction. All sales will be conducted pursuant to N.C.G.S. 160A-270 (b) & (c).
