Consideration of a Resolution Expressing City Council’s Intent Regarding Special Events during the Closure of Business 40.

**Summary of Information:**

Business 40 between Fourth Street and Peters Creek Parkway is scheduled to close for approximately two years beginning November 2018. The highway closure and associated detours will affect traffic flow on surface streets such that any reduction in roadway capacity can create detrimental impacts to traffic flow.

There are also many races, parades and other special events that could affect the same roads that are detour routes for the Business 40 closure.

In order to be sensitive to these impacts but to also provide reasonable accommodation for special events, the attached resolution directs staff to work with event promoters/petitioners to mitigate the impacts of their events by choosing times and routes that will do so.
