RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE ORDER FOR FOUR FIRE TRUCKS

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Department budgeted to replace three pumper fire engines and one

aerial ladder fire engine that have exceeded the minimum replacement criteria; and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2023, the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC), a

cooperative purchasing group, awarded competitive bid contract #FS12-23 per bid specifications

to Atlantic Emergency Solutions, Inc. (Manassas, VA); and

WHEREAS, Atlantic Emergency Solutions, Inc. has offered quotations for three Pierce

Enforcer pumper trucks, meeting contract specifications, in the amount of \$1,122,783 each, plus a

single order processing charge of \$2,000, for a total cost of \$3,370,350; and

WHEREAS, Atlantic Emergency Solutions, Inc. has also offered a quotation for one

Pierce Enforcer 105 aerial ladder truck, meeting contract specifications, in the amount of

\$1,884,670, plus a single order processing charge of \$2,000, for a total cost of \$1,886,670, with

the total for all four trucks being \$5,257,020; and

WHEREAS, the department recommends that a purchase order be awarded to Atlantic

Emergency Solutions, Inc. for four fire trucks. This recommendation is in accordance with

N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3), an exception to formal bidding which authorizes "purchases made

through a competitive bidding group purchasing program, which is a formally organized program

that offers competitively obtained purchasing products and services at discount prices to two or

more public agencies".

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City

of Winston-Salem, upon approval by the Finance Committee, that a purchase order is hereby

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awarded to Atlantic Emergency Solutions, Inc. for three Pierce Enforcer pumper trucks and one Pierce Enforcer aerial ladder truck in the total amount of \$5,257,020.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that award of this purchase order constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidder. The contract specifications of #FS12-23, the vendor's quotes, and the City's purchase order will constitute the contract. The City is not legally bound until the purchase order is duly executed by the City.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this purchase is included as part of the FY 2024-25 capital equipment budget and will be financed through the City's internal leasing program.
