## RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR LANDSCAPING SERVICES HIGHWAY 52 AT RESEARCH PARKWAY

**WHEREAS**, City/County Purchasing issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) on behalf of the Vegetation Management Department to provide landscaping services, and one proposal was received on February 20, 2024, from Champion Landscapes Inc. (Midland, NC); and

**WHEREAS,** terms of the RFP specified detailed evaluation criteria and an evaluation panel of staff members reviewed the proposals received and are recommending award of a contract to Champion Landscapes Inc. in the annual amount of \$166,200; and

**WHEREAS**, terms of the bid reserve the right for the City to extend this contract for two additional 12-month periods, if both parties agree and funds are made available for that purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, it is recommended that a contract for landscaping services per the unit prices offered in the proposal be awarded to Champion Landscapes Inc. for the annual amount of \$166,200.00, with the option to extend for two additional years, for a total potential value of \$498,600.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, upon approval of the Finance Committee, that the contract for landscaping services at Highway 52 at Research Parkway is hereby awarded to Champion Landscapes Inc., in the annual amount of \$166,200.00, and that terms of the contract reserve the right for the City to

extend this contract for two additional 12-month periods, if both

parties agree and funds are made available for that purpose, for a potential total estimated contract value of \$498,600.00, and that the City Manager and City Clerk are authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the City, with contract to be approved by the City Attorney.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the award of this contract constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualification of the bidder. The City is not legally bound to perform the contract until duly executed by the City.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that funding has been appropriated in the FY 2024-25 budget to cover the cost of this contract through June 30,2025, with contract extensions subject to future budget appropriations.
