COLLECTION SERVICES



BRUSH COLLECTION

Collected one quadrant at a time, working in a clockwise direction.

Brush should not exceed 6 inches in diameter and 6 feet in length.

Year round collection.



LEAF COLLECTION

Collected one quadrant at a time, working in a clockwise direction.

Three rounds of leaf collection.



BULKY ITEM

Began March 1, 2021

Accepted items: appliances, carpet, furniture, mattresses, toys.

One collection per neighborhood.



REFUSE

Weekly collection to Winston-Salem residents.

Carts should be at curb by 6am on the day of collection, and no earlier than 5pm the day before collection.

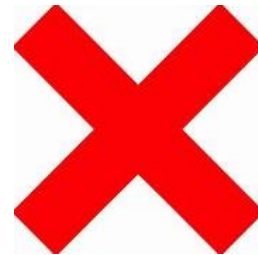
SUMMARY

ACCEPTABLE



- Trunks, branches, limbs, shrubbery smaller than six inches in diameter
- Trunks, branches, limbs, shrubbery shorter than six feet
- Neatly stacked in orderly manner
- Cut ends pointed in the same direction
- Effectively tied to avoid unsightly litter conditions

- Brush mixed with loose leaves and household trash
- Trunks, branches, limbs, and shrubbery larger than six inches in diameter and longer than six feet
- Brush cut by landscapers, tree service contractors, or other commercial workers. This applies to large acreage tracts or vacant lots in addition to residential property



NOT ACCEPTABLE

SEC. 26-9 BRUSH COLLECTION

(a) **Pre-collection requirements.** No tree trunks, branches, limbs, or other shrubbery larger than six inches in diameter and longer than six feet shall be collected by the city.

Tree and shrubbery limbs should have protruding branches trimmed and shall be neatly stacked and placed in an orderly manner on the curb side, with cut ends pointing in the same direction.

Unless subject branches or limbs are of such size not to be blown about and scattered by the elements, they shall be effectively tied so as to avoid unsightly litter conditions

(b) **Separate storage.** Brush and shrubbery trimmings must be stored separately at the curb from yard trash, household trash, and loose leaves.

(c) **Collection by city.** Brush and shrubbery trimmings will be collected by the city when the work has been performed by the property owner or occupant or yard man.

*For purposes of this section, a yard man means a person who works for hire in the upkeep of residential yards).

(d) **Materials not collected by the city.** Tree and shrubbery branches , limbs, and trimmings cut by landscaper or tree service contractors or other commercial workmen or day laborers or resulting from land being cleared by a contractor shall not be collected by the city. This applies to large acreage tracts or vacant lots being developed within the city as well as residential property.

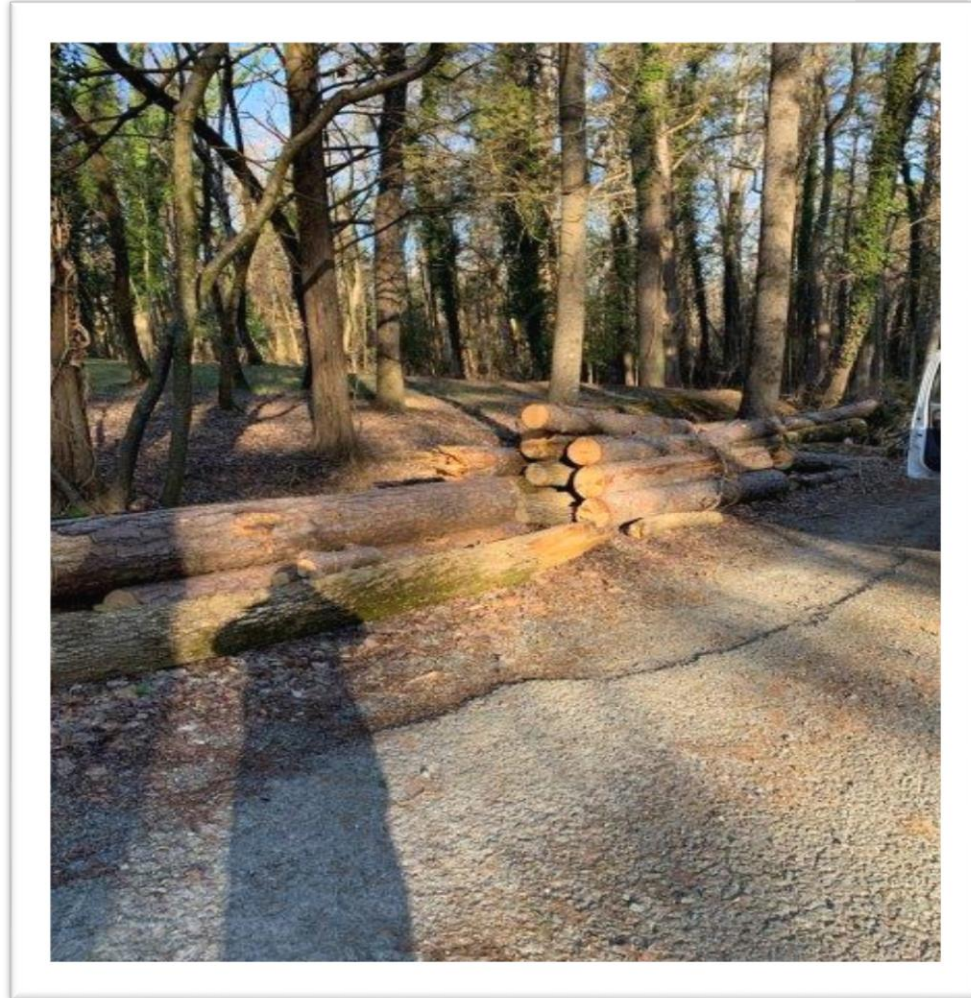

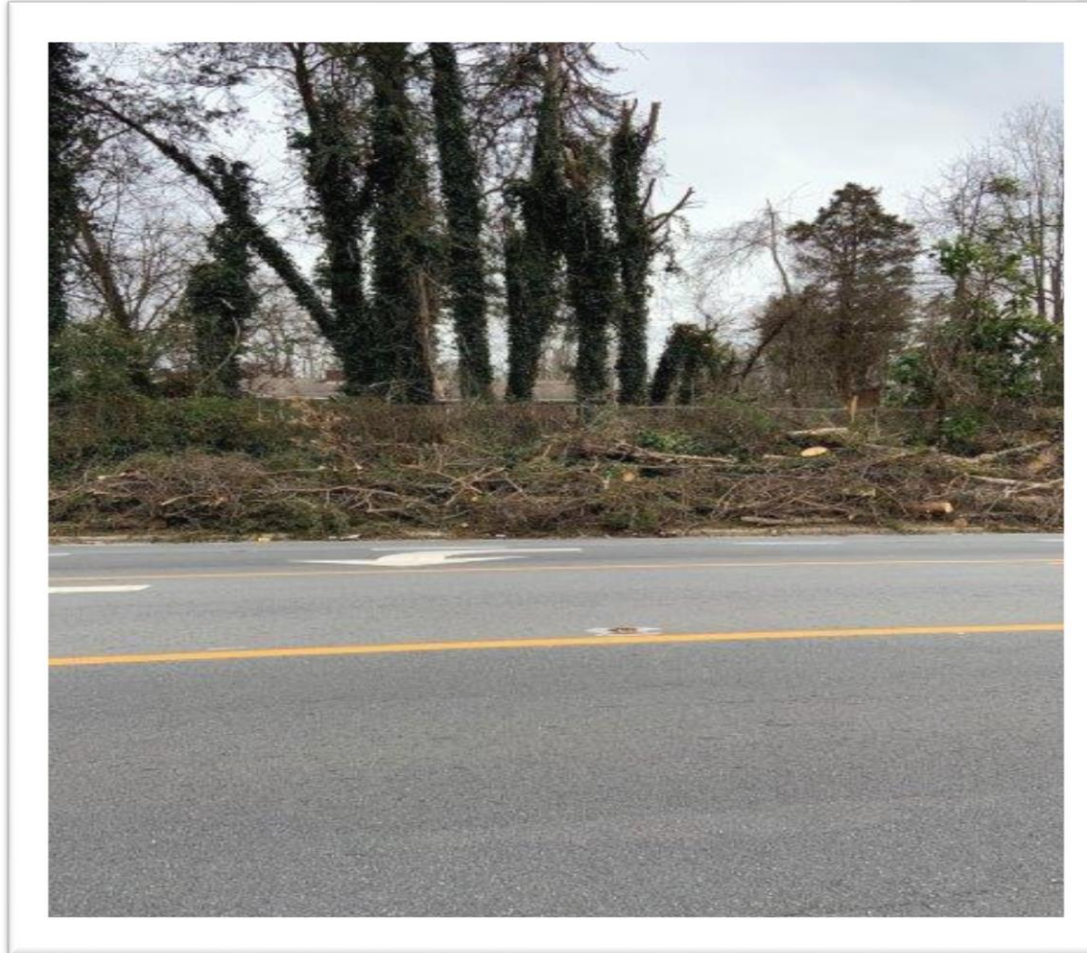
