

**RESOLUTION AWARDING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR
CLOVERDALE AVENUE PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, after proper advertisement, bids were received and publicly opened at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 12, 2023, for construction of the Cloverdale Avenue Pedestrian Improvements and the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) established subcontracting goals for this project with a combined goal of 6% M/WBE, and the low bidder meeting bid specifications, Atlantic Contracting Company, Inc., submitted subcontracting goals of 6.09% with minority and woman-owned businesses, meeting the M/WBE goal; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a contract be awarded to Atlantic Contracting Company, Inc., the low bidder meeting specifications, for construction of the Cloverdale Avenue Pedestrian Improvements in the estimated total amount of \$1,969,490.25.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem hereby approve a contract for construction of the Cloverdale Avenue Pedestrian Improvements per bid specifications is hereby awarded to Atlantic Contracting Company, Inc., in the estimated total amount of \$1,969,490.25 and that the City Manager and City Clerk are authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the City, with contract and bond forms to be approved by the City Attorney and bid deposit retained until the successful bidder has provided satisfactory contract, performance and payment bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of this contract constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidder. The City is not legally bound to perform the

contract until the contract is duly executed by the City. The bid deposit may be retained if the bidder fails to execute the contract or give satisfactory surety as required by N.C.G.S. 143-129.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that award of this contract is contingent upon approval by NCDOT, who will review the City's award recommendation, and that prime bidders and M/WBE subcontractors must be pre-qualified with NCDOT at the time the bids are opened.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Atlantic Contracting Company, Inc. will be required to subcontract, at a minimum, 6.09% of this contract with minority (2.03%) and women-owned businesses (4.06%) as indicated on the required NCDOT Letter of Intent submitted by the company.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$700,000 for this project will come from state grant funds. Funds are available in the City's FY2022-2023 budget to cover the remaining cost of this project.
