Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Approve a Two-Year Extension to the Contract with Transdev Services Inc.

## **Summary of Information**:

Currently, the Winston-Salem Transit Authority has a five-year agreement with Transdev Services Inc. (Transdev) to manage, supervise and conduct the operation of the Transit Transportation Services. The agreement with Transdev is scheduled to end on July 31, 2020. To allow time for the Transit Authority and City Council to consider the options of engaging in a full operations contract or to maintain an administrative contract, staff recommends extending the current contract with Transdev for two more years. Transdev has agreed to a two-year extension with fees totaling \$305,256 in the first year and \$314,064 in the second year. No other terms of their agreement with the Transit Authority will change.
