Bicycle Master Plan Priorities Update

In August 2019, City Council adopted the Bicycle Master Plan, which includes 17 priority corridors to be upgraded with various bicycle infrastructure options, including bicycle lanes, greenways, shared lane markings and others. The Department of Transportation staff have been working to implement recommendations from the plan that align with 2018 bond funded projects. Concurrently, the City's Bicycle/Pedestrian/Active Mobility Advisory Committee (BPAMAC) adopted an annual work program in May 2021 that includes reviewing the Bicycle Master Plan priority corridors and recommending the next group of projects to design and construct. The BPAMAC spent three months reviewing the Bicycle Master Plan recommendations and developed a prioritized list of projects based on an objective analysis of the data used in the plan. Department of Transportation staff will present the BPAMAC's project prioritization results and BPAMAC executive members will attend to share the Committee's achievements from its first year.
