# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED MULTIFAMILY HOUSING REVENUE BONDS FINANCING BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM

Notice is hereby given that a Hearing Officer of the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Winston-Salem (the "Authority") will hold a public hearing on its proposed plan to issue multifamily housing revenue bonds in an amount up to \$14,000,000 (the "Bonds") for the financing of a portion of the cost of the acquisition, retion of the cost of the acquisition, re-habilitation and equipping by Skyline Village Holdings LLC, a North Caroli-na limited liability company, or an affiliated or related entity (the "Borarrillated or related entity (the "Bor-rower") of a low income multifamily residential rental facility known as Skyline Village Apartments, consist-ing of 169 units (the "Developmen-t").
