

**RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR GOLF CART LEASING SERVICES
AT WINSTON LAKE GOLF COURSE**

WHEREAS, the Recreation Department and Winston Lake Golf Course have a need to replace 62 golf carts that meet or exceed replacement criteria; and

WHEREAS, after having made three unsuccessful attempts to solicit proposals for the services through the Purchasing Department, the Recreation Department was able to obtain an informal quotation from the vendor; and

WHEREAS, Yamaha Golf Cart Company of Greensboro, NC has offered a quotation for a five-year lease on 70 Yamaha golf carts at an annual cost of \$52,080 for a total five-year contract amount of \$260,400; and

WHEREAS, the vendor has also offered a credit of \$147,000 in exchange for the trade-in of 62 used EZ-GO golf carts currently in use at the facility; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S 143-129.7 provides "...the awarding authority may award a contract for both the purchase of the apparatus, supplies, materials, or equipment and the sale of trade-in property taking into consideration the amount offered on the trade-in when applying the criteria for award; and

WHEREAS, it is the department's recommendation that a contract for golf cart leasing services in the annual amount of \$52,080 be awarded to Yamaha Golf Cart Company for a total five-year contract award of \$260,400.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that a contract for golf cart leasing services is hereby awarded to Yamaha Golf Cart Company in the annual amount of \$52,080 with five-year total contract amount of \$260,400.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that award of this contract constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidder. The City is not legally bound to perform the contract until the contracts are duly executed by the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funding to cover the cost of this contract's services for FY 23-24 and subsequent years of the leasing agreement are subject to future budget appropriations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the City.
