**Summary of Information:**

The MapForsyth Addressing Team has been in communication with Wake Forest University regarding the addresses on their campus. To ensure timely and accurate response in an emergency, the campus needed address numbers assigned to each of their buildings and streets that would provide access to these buildings would need to be named. MapForsyth staff has been working with Wake Forest staff to review the campus layout and review the new road names. The following names have been requested for the new roads and replacement names for the existing roads. The road name **Wake Forest Road** was requested to be moved from one segment of road to a newly constructed road. **Eure Drive** would connect to segments of Wake Forest Road. **Elizabeth Phillips Way** would extend between Polo Road and Carroll Weathers Drive and would replace the road name Wingate Road. **McPherson Road** would extend between Wake Forest Road and Faculty Drive and replaces the road name Wingate Road. **Crisp Lane** would extend between Wingate Road (proposed McPherson Road) and Wellman Way. MapForsyth has reviewed the requested and it's consistent with the addressing policy.
