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RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR ASPHALT CRACK REPAIRS

WHEREAS, the City of Winston-Salem has the need for a contractor to seal pavement cracks to prolong the life of city streets; and

WHEREAS, after proper advertisement, bids were received and publicly opened by City/County Purchasing at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 10, 2019, for asphalt crack sealing during the period of January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020, and Delta Contracting, Inc., located in Haw River, NC, offered the only bid based on historical usage in the estimated annual amount of \$48,240; and

WHEREAS, terms of the bid allow the City the right to extend the contract for as many as two additional annual periods (until December 31, 2022), if both parties agree and funds are made available for that purpose, and unit prices may be adjusted at the beginning of each additional annual period by an amount not to exceed the latest available Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a contract be awarded to Delta Contracting, Inc., low bidder meeting specifications, for asphalt crack sealing during the period of January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020, in the estimated annual amount of \$48,240 with the option to extend the contract for as many as two additional annual periods (until December 31, 2022), if both parties agree and funds are made available for that purpose, and unit prices may be adjusted at the beginning of each additional annual period by an amount not to exceed the latest available Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers making the total possible award amount over three years in the estimated amount of \$144,720.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that the contract for asphalt crack sealing is hereby awarded to Delta Contracting, Inc., the low bidder meeting specifications, during the period of January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020, in the estimated annual amount of \$48,240 with the option to extend the contract for as many as two additional annual periods (until December 31, 2022), if both parties agree and funds are made available for that purpose, and unit prices may be adjusted at the beginning of each additional annual period by an amount not to exceed the latest available Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers making the total possible award amount over three years in the estimated amount of \$144,720. The City Manager and City Secretary are authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the City, with contract to be approved by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of this contract constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidder. The City is not legally bound to perform the contract until the contract is duly executed by the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds have been previously appropriated in the approved Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budget to cover the cost of this contract from January 1, 2020, through June 30, 2020, and purchases from July 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020, will be subject to City Council Fiscal Year 2020-2021 budget appropriations. Any purchases as result of a contract extension will also be subject to future approved City Council budget appropriations.
