Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Approve a Change Order with APAC-Atlantic, Inc., Thompson-Arthur Division for Additional Construction Services on the 2018 Bond Resurfacing Contract

## **Summary of Information:**

Bids for resurfacing City streets were received and opened on May 9, 2019, and awarded to APAC-Atlantic, Inc., Thompson-Arthur Division Winston-Salem, NC, the low bidder meeting specifications, in the estimated amount not to exceed \$6,174,629 by the Mayor and City Council on June 3, 2019. This contract will resurface approximately 23 miles of City streets funded by the 2018 bonds. A change order in the amount of \$534,066.10 was approved by Council in August 2019 to add base repair to the contract. In October 2019 Council approved a change order in the amount of \$832,300.95 for additional streets, paving of Winston-Salem Transit Authority (WSTA) parking lots and installing a raised table on London Lane.

The contractor has agreed to additional quantities to expand the WSTA bus parking lot. APAC has prepared a change order for \$141,312.00 based on estimated quantities.

Staff is recommending approval authorizing the City Manager to execute a change order with APAC-Atlantic, Inc., Thompson-Arthur Division Winston-Salem, NC for this additional work. This would revise the contract total to \$7,540,996.05. All funds will come from a WSTA grant and have been approved by the WSTA Board of Directors at their meeting in April 2020.
