Summary of Information:

At the April Public Works Committee Meeting Council Member Larson questioned the language in the proposed “Architectural Lighting Policy for Displays within the Public Right-of-Way”. Specifically he questioned why the policy stated: “Lighting may be enabled 1-hour after sunset and must be disabled 1-hour prior to sunrise.”

Staff reviewed and determined that the language should state” Lighting may be enabled **1-hour before sunset** and must be disabled **1-hour after sunrise.**” The language in the policy has been modified to reflect this correction.
