
As part of the FY 2020-21 budget planning process, staff was directed to provide regular updates on major revenues. Since the approval of the FY 2020-21 budget, the City has received the distribution of sales tax from sales made in April, as well as the quarterly distribution of utility franchise taxes (i.e., piped natural gas, electricity, telecommunications, and video programming) and ABC revenues.

Attached is the Revenue Report for August. It includes an update on General Fund revenues and charts showing trends for Sales Taxes, Occupancy Tax Fund, Utilities Franchise Tax Fund, Fairgrounds Fund, and Parking Fund.


