- Developer shall secure all required financing before any City funds disbursed

Total Project Cost: ~\$15 M \$2 M City funds for 1007 Building (Phase I of total project) Based on Community Development Statute

- Developer requested City assistance be moved to the 1007 building for construction upfit
- Information Item

Financial Assistance for Marshall Street Project

Current Request

Cost-Phase I (1007): ~\$16.2 M

Cost-Phase II (1001): ~\$31.2 M

Based on Community Development Statute

- Developer requests \$1 M for Phase I and \$1 M for Phase II
- City funds would be last money in for each phase
- City's commitment for both phases would terminate if Phase I is not operational within 18 months of execution of development agreement
- Phase II commitment would terminate if not operational within 24 months of activation of Phase I
