### CITY MANAGER UPDATE

The City Manager, William Pate provided updates on council members attending the National League of Cities Conference and congressional visits, discussing topics like budgeting, safe communities, affordable housing, and federal funding. Although, they met with senators and asked about the federal budget, there is a little optimism about receiving it before adopting the local budget in June, 2025.

The Meadowlark Drive project is expected to be completed by the end of April, 2025.

The Fire Department held a graduation ceremony on March 14, 2025 for 24 new firefighters.

In addition, ahead of the council session, Mr. Pate emphasized the importance of the updates for the Fire Department from 2014 to 2025. He listed the improvements such as, increase in staff positions from 343 to 400, the none-personnel operating budget rising by 120%, and major Capital improvements including renovations of Stations No. 7, No. 8 and No. 9, construction of Station No. 13, land purchase for Station No. 4, and other projects, totaling approximately \$18 million.

Council Member Scott Andree-Bowen asked a question about an increased water bill and the Assistant City Manager King gave a brief update on the billing cycle change caused by cyber event in December.
