**Council Action Requested:**

Consideration of a Resolution to Name the Strollway Bridge over Salem Creek.

**Summary of Information:**

The Recreation and Parks Department at their April 4, 2017, meeting received a request from Council Member John C. Larson, South Ward to name the Salem Creek Strollway Bridge “The Molly Leight Crossing” after former Council Member Molly Leight. Please see the attached letter.

The Salem Creek Strollway Bridge is located in the South Ward near the Gateway YWCA. As required by the City Council adopted policy on the naming of City-owned buildings and facilities, the advisory body overseeing the facility, in this case the Recreation and Parks Commission, has approved a resolution recommending that the strollway bridge be named “The Molly Leight Crossing”.
