

**RESOLUTION EXPRESSING APPRECIATION TO THE HONORABLE
JEFF MACINTOSH FOR HIS SERVICE AS COUNCIL MEMBER**

WHEREAS, Mr. Jeff MacIntosh has served as a Council Member for the City of Winston-Salem since December 2013, representing the Northwest Ward; and

WHEREAS, Council Member MacIntosh earned a Bachelor of Arts in Economics from Wake Forest University in 1980 and acquired a North Carolina Real Estate License in 1985; and

WHEREAS, Council Member MacIntosh has been a strong advocate for sound public policy, serving in key roles such as Chair of the Public Works Committee, Vice Chair of the Public Safety Committee, and as a member of the Finance Committee; and

WHEREAS, Council Member MacIntosh played a key role in securing the final funding for the 92 acre conservation easement on the Crossnore land, helping to secure the largest urban greenspace in Winston-Salem for future generations; and

WHEREAS, Council Member MacIntosh advocated for the renovations of several parks, including Hanes Park, 2nd Street Park, and Spring Park; and

WHEREAS, Council Member MacIntosh tirelessly championed the construction of Merschel Park in downtown Winston-Salem which was completed in April 2023; and

WHEREAS, Council Member MacIntosh served on the Kaleideum Board and played a significant role in the merger of SciWorks and the Children's Museum into Kaleideum which opened its downtown facility in 2023; and

WHEREAS, Council Member MacIntosh's knowledge and experience in real estate development has proven invaluable as the City considered complex real estate projects to ensure that the City and the residents were well protected as the financial package was structured; and

WHEREAS, Council Member MacIntosh has served on the board of the NC League of Municipalities, and previously on the board of Preserve Historic Forsyth, while also serving as President of the Holly Avenue Neighborhood Association, where he facilitated traffic changes on Holly Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Council Member MacIntosh has provided valuable leadership in advocating for affordable housing, completion of Public Works capital projects, improved policies for street resurfacing, historic preservation, progressive planning policies, and refocusing City efforts on public transit.
