6. If any shelter is unable to accept its grant funds, the funds will be distributed among the remaining shelters in proportion to the amounts shown above.

7. The amount of any other funds to be awarded by the State is subject to determination by the State and may include funds for administration of the ESG program and administration of the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS). The amount of such funds shown in the table above is estimated.
