## **Summary of Information:**

The Recreation and Parks Commission, at its October 1, 2019 meeting, received a request from Council Member Jeff MacIntosh, Northwest Ward, to name the newly constructed pedestrian overlook at Hanes Park after Mr. William "Bill" Bloxham. This request was unanimously approved by the Recreation and Parks Commission at their October 1, 2019 meeting. Please see the attached letter.

Mr. William "Bill" Bloxham was a street person who was very shy, but well known in the community. Bill was known as a gentle and intelligent soul and spent most of his time near Hanes Park. A few years ago, Bill was viciously beaten, and subsequently died a few months later. Bill's one remaining family member as well as members of the community are in support of this recommendation to remember Bill in a permanent way.

As required by the City Council adopted policy on naming of City-owned buildings and facilities, the advisory body overseeing the facility, in this case the Recreation and Parks Commission supports a resolution recommending the pedestrian overlook at Hanes Park be named the William "Bill" Bloxham overlook.
